ASR Qualifiers	Division Coordinators meet on the Thursday night after Divisional Relays and notifications to the teams (pools) are made immediately afterwards.			
Scratches and Substitutions	Team reps should provide any Relay Team scratches to: NVSLallstars@gmail.com, your Division Coordinator and lknvsl@hotmail.com ASAP. The team will be removed from the meet and the 1st Alternate will be notified. Scratched teams will be recognized in the Meet Program.			
	<u>One</u> swimmer substitution may be made at any time per NVSL Rules 5 and 21. Substitutions made before 3 PM Sunday prior to ASR meet will have the substitute's name printed in the meet program.			
	For best practices/good sportsmanship, Team Reps should email any late scratches and substitutions immediately upon knowledge to NVSLallstars@gmail.com, their Division Coordinator, and lknvsl@hotmail.com. If occuring at meet - immediately submit them at the Scratch Table.			
Meet Officials provided by your team	Each Division Coordinator will identify their teams' requirements for Meet Officials. Team Reps are to provide names of persons working as officials to their Division Coordinator by 12:00 PM, Sunday , so they can be published in the Meet Program and placed on the parking lot access list. Prior to the meet, Team Reps must notify their Officials working the meet to check-in to obtain access to deck areas. Deck Officials are to arrive no later than 3 PM on Meet Day. Failure to provide a name prior the publication cutoff times does not relieve the Division/Team of their obligation. This is an Open House warm-up for swimmers to become familiar with the pool and for the Coaches and Team Reps to become familiar with the site configuration. Specific age group lanes will be available for practicing relay starts and transition starts only. This is not the time for a practice. 8 & U have a separate lane. It is advisable to have a second coach if coaching additional age groups.

Thank you for respecting the rules and being kind to those running the events. All are volunteers.

Meet Day

	Team areas may be set up in the field surrounding LPRC, as marked, after 7 AM on the meet day. Anyone on or		
	near Holmes MS property and/or LPRC property before 7 AM will be considered trespassers and the authorities		
	may be called.		
	Tents and awnings are strongly encouraged. Grills, generators, and fires are NOT allowed in team areas. Off -		
Team Areas	limits areas are clearly marked and will be strictly enforced. Anyone found selling food will be evicted from		
	the field and lose your place in line.		
	LPRC will provide changing tents for swimmers who need to change on-site. No access to bath house changing		
	rooms or bathrooms will be permitted for participants or spectators. Portable restrooms will be located close		
	to the entrance on the LPRC grounds.		
	At 7 AM the LPRC back lawn will be open for general parking (no commercial vehicles or large buses). It is		
	accessible from Montrose. The area will be entrance only until full. At which time, it will become exit only.		
	LPRC has also arranged for parking at Holmes Middle School, next door, with a path through the trees to LPRC;		
	Weyanoke Elementary School after 4:30 PM (across Braddock Rd from Braddock Baptist); and Thomas Jefferson		
	HS stadium lot after 12 PM (entrance on Braddock) with path to Weyanoke. Additional overflow parking for		
	those leaving before free relays start is available at Braddock Baptist Church up until 6PM (at the corner of		
	Braddock and Montrose). In order to allow sufficient space for Emergency Vehicles and to maintain traffic		
	flow, there will be NO street parking on Montrose. There is limited street parking on side streets, but please		
	use provided parking lots first to minimize neighborhood disruption. Please do not park in intersections or block		
Parking	fire hydrants or driveways. Commercial vehicles and large buses must be parked at TJ AND NOT ON		
	NEIGHBORHOOD STREETS during the event and are to coordinate with Andrew Wise at		
	andrewwise5@gmail.com prior to the event. Be a good neighbor - Follow the guidelines please!		
	The LPRC front parking lot is reserved for working officials and meet volunteers with heavy loads & equipment,		
	meet concessions and vendors, and special guests.		
	The pool will provide 4 Handicapped Parking spaces during the day of the meet that are available only by		
	reservation for teams and spectators. Anyone needing handicapped parking must make prior arrangements		
	with Andrew Wise at andrewwise5@gmail.com. People who do not make prior arrangements will not be able		
	to utilize the Handicapped Parking. All special guests requiring handicapped parking will be accomodated and		
	are requested to advise LPRC in advance.		
	The designated Swimmer Drop Off area is in the Holmes MS parking lot at the corner closest to the pool. Drivers		
Swimmer Drop Off	should enter the Holmes parking lot on the side closest to Braddock Road and follow signs around the main		
	entrance to drop off at the corner nearest to LPRC. Please drop off swimmers and then proceed to the available		
	parking areas. Handicapped Drop Off is at the entrance to the pool lot.		
Ch a als lin	Upon arrival, use spectator entrance. Team Reps and the Head Coach should report to the Team		
Check-In	Rep/Coach/VIP Check-in near the gate to sign-in and receive your team's meet program, the Coaches' meet		
Minusin - A	sheet, and one Team Rep's and one Coach's wristband for access to reserved viewing areas.		
Viewing Areas	There are designated viewing areas for Team Reps and coaches.		
	The Host Pool will open to the public at 2:00 PM.		
	Lining up early to enter the pool area is strongly discouraged. The entry line prior to 2 PM will be marked.		
1	Marshals will escort the line to the pool entrance at 1:55 PM to ensure an orderly admission.		

	Reserving bleacher seats with anything larger than a beach towel (approx. 6 ft. in length) is strictly prohibited.			
	One person may reserve no more than two seats with one beach towel and must occupy that towel . Marshals			
(Please be good	will remove materials covering bleachers to "reserve" seats except as described above. Please encourage your			
sports and share	swimmers to leave the bleachers open for adults and non-swimming children. Umbrellas will not be			
the space)	permitted in the bleachers.			
	* One area of bleachers will be designated as short-term only meaning the entire area will be vacated after			
	EVERY EVENT to allow all spectators the opportunity to watch their swimmers. Deck area surrounding the bleachers will be limited. To facilitate the movement of pedestrian traffic on the			
	deck, certain areas will be designated "NO STANDING" and a Marshal will be positioned to maintain pedestrian			
	flow.			
	An area for disabled seating and a disabled restroom will be available.			
Warm-Ups	Warm-ups are per the schedule. Swimmers must clear the pool in a timely manner.			
	Relay starts will not be permitted at any time. One way sprint lanes will be available in designated lanes.			
	Entrance to the pool for Warm-Ups will be through the "Swimmer Only" entrance at the Clerk of Course.			
	Coaches are responsible for ensuring their swimmers report to Clerk-of-Course on time. 1st Alternates should			
Clerk-of-Course	report to the Clerk of Course when their event is called. Alternate Teams will be escorted to the deck and will			
	be placed in the meet should a seeded team not be available to compete.			
DQs	If a disqualification occurs, the Team Rep will be notified immediately after the heat ONLY if that Team Rep is			
DQS	available in the Team Rep viewing area.			
	As events end, results will be posted at the meet. Full results can be found on the NVSL website after the			
Results	conclusion of the meet. Results may also be available on Meet Mobile App.			
	Awards are given for 1st through 18th places. All competitors and alternates receive All Star Patches. Team			
Awards and	Reps should pick up their team's medals, ribbons, and patches at the Awards Area after their team's last event.			
Patches	Trophies are awarded at the end of the meet to teams finishing with the six highest point totals.			
Scholarship	The MacDuff, Presidents, Spirit, Joan Olson and Lou Sharp scholarships will be presented prior to the start of the			
Awards	meet.			
Concessions and	Food and refreshments will be offered by the Host Pool and our NVSL food vendors. NVSL advertisers will have			
Vendors	products for sale throughout the evening. Please support our advertisers! No outside food will be allowed			
	within the pool fence enclosure.
