 - Announcements, calendar, documents and records





Team Manager 8.0 (TM)


- "Filing cabinet"
- Store administrative info for swimmers
- Team registration (optional)
- Maintain team records
- Select swimmers for meets
- Store meet results
- Generate team level reports
- Track performance
- B meet functions:
 - Time cards
 - Awards
- One database (*.MDB file) per NVSL team






Meet Manager 8.0 (MM)

- Merge meet entry files from multiple teams
- Seed swimmers into heats and lanes
- Print meet programs, time cards
- Record times/DQs and score meets
- Print meet results and ribbon labels
- One database (*.MDB file) per NVSL meet





How TM and MM Work Together





High-level Data Flow

BOTH TEAMS

After last meet: Run reports (PB, ladders, etc.)

Mon/Tues: Import TM events (meet "skeleton")

Wed: Create entries (swimmer selections)

Run reports to check your entries

Export roster and records Entry List

HOST TEAM ONLY

Wed: Import MM events (meet "skeleton")

Thu: Import entries/rosters/records

Thu: Seed meet

Thu: Send out meet sheets

Fri: Print time cards

Sat AM: Run meet

Sat PM: Generate meet reports

Sat PM: Export results, send to DDC

BOTH TEAMS

Sat/Sun: Import results

Sat/Sun: Generate meet/team reports

Getting the Software

- Need both TM 8.0 and MM 8.0 on PC laptop
- Contact Michelle Hale at <u>NVSLTechnology@gmail.com</u> if you need to install TM &/or MM on a new laptop
- Installation instructions on website in Documents at Hy-Tek (A-Meets)/Procedures/Software Installation




Software Quirks

- You can run the Olympics!
- (Nearly) All changes saved automatically
- Zip files/1001 clicks to open a file
- Collated printing doesn't work; save as PDF, then print
- B meet time card printing glitch



TM System Age-Up Date

- Meet and System Age-Up settings controls how the software determines a swimmers age for reports and various information screens
- For the NVSL a swimmer's competition age is determined by his/her age on June 1st
 - Meet Age-up Date is used by default if not specified in meet events file
 - It is recommended that the System Age-Up setting be set to June 1st
 - You can always change the setting if a swimmer's true age is required






Add/Modify Athletes in TM



- Be sure to enter birthdates for all swimmers
- Can make all your swimmers inactive and then activate them as they register for the new season



TM Duplicate Swimmer Names



- Check your TM database for duplicate swimmers
 - Most common issue is one with a middle initial and one without
- Drag swimmer to drop onto the other (the one to keep) or edit the athlete information of the one to drop




TM No Swimmer Athletes

- No Swimmers = Dummy swimmers to fill in empty lanes
- Need enough No Swimmers in your TM database to fill in all empty lanes with the same restrictions as real swimmers (age, gender, maximum entries)
- Samples:
 - Swimmer, No1 (No2, No3)
 - NoSwimmer, Boy1 (Boy2, Boy3)



File Structure and Directories

- Organize your meet files by directories
 - Create a separate subdirectory for each meet
 - Put every file associated with a meet in its subdirectory
 - C:\Hy-Sport\Meets\2025\meet name
 - Example meet name: 2025-06-23 A-Meet DH@DT





Naming Conventions

- Course naming conventions
 - 25 yard pool = SCY = Yards = Y
- Typical High School and College pools
- 25 meter pool = SCM = Short Course = S
- Most common in NVSL
- 50 meter pool = LCM = Long Course = L
- ← Olympic size pools
- Y', S', etc. means converted time, used inconsistently
- NVSL meet name (internal meet name)
 - NVSL A-Meet HV@FMW
- NVSL meet database (filename)
 - 2025-06-14 NVSL A-Meet HV@FMW.mdb
- NVSL meet events file (filename)
 - Meet Events-NVSL A-Meet HV@FMW-14Jun2025-001.zip
- Record files (files containing team or league records, *.rec file name)
 - Use team abbreviation for internal name, e.g., PT or DL
 - External *.REC exported name will automatically become PT-S.REC or DL-Y.REC where "-S" indicates short course (meters) and "-Y" indicates yards



Definitions

- A <u>meet</u> consists of a collection of <u>events</u> (e.g. Boys 8&Under 25 Meter Freestyle) which may be grouped into <u>sessions</u>
- A <u>session</u> is a group of <u>events</u>, not typically used by NVSL
 - Typical example from Potomac Valley Swimming:

Morning session: 13 & Over Prelims

Afternoon session: 12 & Under Timed Finals

Evening session: 13 & Over Finals

- Division Individual Championship has multiple sessions
- An <u>event</u> is swum with one or more <u>heats</u>
 - Division Individual Championship (Divisionals), All Star Relays, and Individual All Stars have multiple heats
- Hierarchy is Meet/Session/Event/Heat



Downloading Meet Events

Download generic meet events file from NVSL Website – www.mynvsl.com

- Documents tab
- Hy-Tek (A-Meets) / 2025 / Week 1: June 14 / METERS or YARDS folder
- 2 files: Meet Events for TM and Meet Backup (Swmm8Bkup) for MM



Save files to the folder setup for the meet

(C: > Hy-Sport > Meets > [Year] > [Meet])

- Visiting Team only needs the Meet Events file
- Host Team needs both the Meet Events and Meet Backup file




Import Meet Events into TM

- File | Import | Meet Events
 - Meet events files are created by the NVSL for A-Meets and posted to the NVSL website. Each team should download the events file from the website.
 - [B-Meets] Someone (possibly you) will have provided you with an Events file template for B-Meets
 - Generally the templates are also posted to the NVSL website
 - Select the appropriate Events file or Events file template
 - After clicking OK, the new meet will appear on the Meets screen (scroll to the top if you don't see it!)
 - Open the meet (double click on the name), verify the information (teams, course, date, etc.), and (optional) change Meet Type to "A"



Importing Meet Events

From Main Menu select File | Import | Meet Events – follow on screen directions From Main Menu select Meets and this screen will come up






Entering Athletes in Meet

- On the Meets screen, highlight the meet for which you wish to create entries
- Entries | Swimmer Entry Status (Optional)
 - Pre-enter all swimmers, then clear anyone on your unavailable list for that meet
- Entries | Entry by Event
 - Set the Only Pre-Entered Athletes checkbox to mask unavailable swimmers (if you chose to pre-enter)
 - Swimmers will show up by their age on the day of the meet
 - Proceed through the events, one by one, entering swimmers
 - You can supply custom times to control lane assignments
 - A warning message will appear if you exceed an entry limit. The entry which caused the warning will nevertheless be created, requiring a correction on your part.




Pre-Entering Athletes in a Meet

- Click on underlined column heading to sort by that column
- Click on letter to show swimmers with last name beginning with letter




Entering Athletes in Meet, cont.

- To enter swimmers in a relay...
 - Set/clear the checkboxes at the left side of the screen as appropriate
 - Select your team from the Swim for Team and Team combo boxes
 - Create a relay by clicking New Relay
 - Add swimmers to your relay by double-clicking or dragging them
 - Remove swimmers by double-clicking them
 - Swap the legs of two swimmers by dragging one on top of the other
 - Find Best Relay only works for 8&Under and 15-18 age groups

- After entries are completed, you should run some reports from the Reports | Meet Reports | Meet Entries dialog
 - Individual and Relays sorted by Meet Event Number
 - Individual and Relays sorted by Name

- "No swimmer" entry if fewer than 3
- Swimmers of proper ages
- 4 swimmers for relays
- Proper ages for mixed age relay
- Right swimmers in the right events

Create entries

HOT TIPS

- Work with team rep for clear/accurate meet declaration process...your sanity depends on it!
- Double-check your entries...it's easy to hit the wrong checkbox
- Enter "No Swimmers" so you have full lanes in all events
- Watch for "too many entries" flags
- Run reports to check max events per swimmer/max swimmers per event
- Run reports by event (for coach review) and by swimmer (for parent review). Can toggle to include/omit times
- Be sure to include relays when exporting...check the box!
- Allow time for corrections before data exchange












Export Team Roster from TM



Prepare Meet Database

- Download the Meet Backup file from the NVSL website
 - Save to the directory set up for the meet
- Open Meet Manager and from the main menu select
 - File | Restore to restore the database
 - Select "Unzip, copy database to a selected folder, and open this new database" option
 - Set-up | Meet Set-up to edit the meet information
 - Meet name and location information
 - Verify meet and age up dates
 - File | Save As and edit the file name with visiting and host team initials to properly identify meet
 - Delete the generic version once the specific one is created



MM Import Entries and Rosters

- File | Import | Entries
 - Import the entries for both teams (any order)
 - Run Reports | Exceptions Report
 - Highlight Session 1
 - Click Exceed Maximum Entries per Athlete, set limits to 4/2/2
 - Create Report
 - Click Exceed Maximum Entries per Team per Event, set limit to 3
 - Create Report
 - No data is good, means there are no problems
- File | Import | Rosters Only
 - Import the rosters for both teams that are in the meet



Import Records into MM, cont.


- This step should wait until after Entries and Rosters have been imported
- Meet database will have NVSL records and All Star time standards included
- Select each team's "record set", and use the edit dialog to set:
 - Identifying flags
 - Teams to which records apply













Assign Teams to Lanes in MM

- Set-up | Seeding Preferences => Dual Meets
 - Host team in lanes 1, 3 and 5
 - Double click or drag team name to appropriate lane






Seed A-Meet Events in MM





Create the Meet Program

- Reports | Memorized Reports => 2 Column meet sheet for distribution => Run Report
 - Highlight All in the session list, select all of the seeded events, then click Create Report
 - Entry times vs no times
 - Review with other team, make corrections if necessary
 - Print plenty of copies (Referee, Starter, Stroke & Turn Judges, Announcer, Clerks of Course, Coaches, Head Timer, etc.)






A-Meet Program

Records and previous year All Star qualifying time

- Host team in lanes 1, 3 and 5
- No seed times
- Fastest swimmers in middle lanes or where desired
- Only 1 heat of 6 swimmers




- Record Flags and Standards
 - All-star cuts and NVSL records are included in the meet database provided by the NVSL
 - '!' is reserved for NVSL records
 - All* is used for projected All-star cuts (qualifying times)



Print A-Meet Time Cards

- Reports **Memorized Reports** => Cards sorted by lane => Run Report
 - Select All in the list of sessions
 - Select the events for which you need time cards – generally Select All
 - Create Labels
 - Be sure to maintain event/lane order







Verify Scoring Preferences

- Set-up | Entry / Scoring
 Preferences => 2 or 3+ Double
 Dual => Select Teams
 - Verify Female, Male and
 Combined are checked and
 both teams are listed
 - If you don't do this on Thursday,
 MM will generate a warning once the results of the first event are "Scored" on Saturday morning



How Times and Scores are Recorded

- Three stopwatches; middle time used
 - Timers verify their time on the timecard before clearing watch
 - Head Lane Timer writes down middle time on card
- Chief Timer quickly checks timecards before passing to Place Recorders
- Place Recorders verify correct official time, attach DQ slips, check for records and write down place on cards
- Data Entry enters watch times into HY-TEK and calls back times and places to Time Caller
 - Prints out event results for verifier
- Verifiers check results against timecards. When confirmed correct:
 - Passes printed event results to Announcer
 - Notifies Data Entry
 - Upload event results to Meet Mobile
 - Print out award labels for ribbons (after each stroke block is complete)
- At end of meet, Data Entry prints out official results
- Referee reviews results, noting correct DQs, and signs results



Run an A-Meet

- Enter times; do not enter times for disqualified swimmers
 - No punctuation or mental arithmetic is required 12345 will be translated to 1:23.45
 - Enter NS (no swim), DFS (declared false start), or DNF (did not finish) as appropriate
- Check DQ (disqualification) box if appropriate
- Event status will change values as you enter times and score events – Seeded, Done, Scored
- Record-breakers will be highlighted in the Records subwindow
- After an event is Done, you need to explicitly Score the event.
 Scores will appear in the Scores sub-window.
- When an event is scored, a results window comes up => print, pass to "Verifier" to check against time cards
- If you correct a time in a scored event, then you need to explicitly Re-Score the event



Run an A-Meet in MM, cont.

Run, continued

- Use Adjust: F8 to change swimmers. If the swimmer is not in the meet, you will need to create the swimmer via Athletes. If you make up a birthday or use a nickname, you will have to reconcile this later in TM.
- In the Adjust: F8 window, double-click a swimmer to remove her from a heat. Then set the Show Eligible Athletes radio button. Finally, drag the replacement swimmer to the lane that was emptied.
- Use Rel Names: Ctrl-R to adjust relay swimmers. Doubleclick a swimmer to remove her from a relay. Drag an eligible athlete onto a relay to make her part of the relay. Drag one relay swimmer onto another to swap relay legs for the two swimmers.




Run an A-Meet in MM, cont.

- Run, continued
 - DO NOT re-seed an event after changing swimmers, unless you want to re-print time cards and meet programs
 - If you replace a swimmer for a scored event, you will have to re-enter her time and re-score the event





Print Award Labels

- After every stroke block and results have been verified
- Reports |
 Memorized Reports
 => Award Labels All
 Places => Run
 Report
 - Note that labels for each team can be printed separately
- Print labels for all individual and relay places





MM Meet Mobile

- Meet Manager 8 supports a smartphone application called Meet Mobile.
 - Users subscribe annually or monthly
 - Psych sheets, heat sheets, rosters, records and time standards can be available before the meet and results by event and swimmer, places and scores during meet (data entry computer must be connected to internet to enable near real-time results during the meet)
 - To charge for meet data team needs an Active.com account
- League policy
 - Publish psych sheets, meet programs, etc. at team discretion including charging a fee (may want to coordinate with Division)
 - Manually publish results only after verified at the table and if not under protest. Publish scores at the end of the meet.
- Meet Mobile operation (see User Guide and A-Meet Procedures)
 - Set-up | Meet Mobile Publishing to publish pre-meet information
 - Run | Meet Mobile to publish near real-time results
 - Uncheck Activate the Meet Mobile System
 - Ctrl-M from Run screen to publish results, Ctrl-O to publish scores




- Cards should come to you in lane order
- To read or not to read cards? Personal preference
- Check place order on computer against cards
- Set up Preferences>Results for List and Score so you include league/team records and scores (for the announcer)
- Do not print labels until results have been verified
- Be sure to check printer contents (paper vs labels) before you print
- Double-check label size before printing
- Keep scratch forms, attach to results (take photo, provide to other teams as agreed)

 - Your DDC will send these to everyone




Import Meet Results into TM

- After the meet is over, File | Import | Meet Results
 - Athletes and times from either or both teams can be brought into your team database
 - DDC will also provide files from other teams in your division



TM Update Team Records



- Mixed Age 200 Freestyle Relay is seen by software same as 15-18 200 Freestyle Relay (Relay Carnival) so best not to let software automatically update records after Relay Carnival or at all
- If your team tracks 8&Under IM records you also need to make a 10&Under IM record for Divisionals – event name has to match
- 8&Under Medley Relay is now a true medley relay not a modified relay, to preserve modified medley relay record need to create a new event such as 200 Medley Relay



Generate Reports in TM

- Reports | Meet Results
 - Display by event or by swimmer
 - Time improvement shown is against best time in system unless you specify otherwise
- Reports | Performance
 - Check for and update team records via Record Match
 - Be careful after Relay Carnival as the 15-18 200 Free Relay will update the Mixed Age 200 Free Relay record
 - Preview record breakers prior to checking Update Records checkbox
 - Generate team ladders via Top Times
 - Generate results reports via Meet Results
 - When you find a report you like, tell TM to memorize it



Post-Meet Activities



- Import data from DDC for ALL teams in your division, including your meet (because DDC performs checks)
- Run records check but do NOT auto-update records; update manually instead
- Generate dual ladders for next meet using Local Swim Club designator (Tip 07 in the <u>Tips folder</u>)



- Don't struggle ask for help
- Follow the instructions
- Backup, backup, backup: both team and meet
- Use recommended file name format/location
- Be sure you're accessing the right meet
- Be attentive to team abbreviations
- Run *all* the verification reports

- SwimTopia site has lots of good information about connecting the systems.
- IGNORE Meet Maestro It's Swimtopia's version of Meet Manager. NVSL uses Meet Manager for all A Meets.
- Importing Athletes to Team Manager
 - You may get duplicate athletes if the swimmer was registered with a slightly different name (usually middle initial).
 - Always correct the athlete name in SwimTopia. This prevents duplicates showing up on the NVSL athlete time history.
- Importing Meet Events to Swimtopia
 - You can import meet templates provided by NVSL. Once you have done one A
 Meet and one B Meet, you can just copy from those to create the remaining
 meets.
 - Divisionals and Relay Carnival events are already available on the NVSL site.
 - You can also set up Meet Templates (A, B, IM, Relays, Divisionals, etc) in SwimTopia and re-use year to year.
- Help. The Help self-service and ability to email are your friend. SwimTopia email response is relatively quick and has always been helpful for me.
