

Swimtopia & Team Manager

Background: 2025 is Hamlet's 9th year using Swimtopia (ST). We have maximized ST and TM/MM integration because we find ST to be user friendly. We appreciate that it has a user friendly interface and multiple users can be set up to "manage" the team including team reps, coaches, data coordinators, volunteer managers, event/party planners, etc. There are many ways to use the ST – this is how we use it. (Our dive team also uses ST for registration and management – we are happy to share how we set up registration to accommodate discounts, etc. offline.)

Beginning of the season

- Create registration form
 - If you have a "Little Feet", i.e., Junior team, create registration group
 - Our junior team athletes are non-competitive but can be moved up to the "Big Feet" during the year
- Create meet templates for both A & B meets
 - A meet templates
 - Hamlet does not allow parents to register themselves for A meets; however, meet availability is critical.
 - Create entry rules

Entry Rules

Template Locking

- ☐ Prevent any changes to the event schedule or entry rules for meets linked to this template.

Qualification

- ☒ Allow entries using "custom times" ⓘ
- ☐ Require entry times to be faster than or equal to the "Faster Than" time for the event ⓘ
- ☐ Require entry times to be slower than the "Slower Than" time for the event ⓘ

Individual Events

- ☒ Allow individual swim-up entries ⓘ

Relay Events

- Maximum relay teams per event ⓘ
- For mixed competition category relay teams, require at least ⓘ of each competition category
- ☐ Require an individual event entry for relay eligibility ⓘ
- ☒ Allow athletes to enter multiple relays of the same stroke (e.g. more than one freestyle relay) ⓘ
- ☒ Allow relay swim-up entries ⓘ
- Allow no more than ⓘ swim-up athletes per relay team
- ☐ Allow entry of relay alternates ⓘ

Save

- Create B Meet templates
 - Hamlet has multiple B meet templates depending on whether the home team swims separate 6 & under events for certain races, whether IM will be swum, etc.
 - It is imperative that the home and visiting team agree on event order etc.
- Create schedule
- Apply template to each meet on the schedule
- For each meet create team preferences
 - Hamlet's A meet preference

Freestyle relay order strategy

- Create time trial template
- Create volunteer templates

Upon registration completion

- Archive prior athletes
- Export athlete roster from ST
- Import athlete roster from ST

During the season

- A Meet
 - We seed the meet in ST. When the coaches are ready to seed the meet, close the meet on the status page.
 - Once meet is seeded, lock the meet. Export the roster and the meet entries.
 - Import the entries and roster.
 - Proceed to follow NVSL instructions. In theory, you do not need to run the reports to check for entry limits if your templates are set up correctly; however, Hamlet still does just to be sure.
 - Upon completion of the meet, import results from the meet into ST.
- B Meet
 - Parents register their children.
 - Once meet is seeded, lock the meet. Export the roster and the meet entries.
 - Import the entries and roster.
 - Run the meet in TM.
 - Export results from TM.
 - Import results into ST.
- Events
- Communication
- Other
 - We do only allow parents to note availability for divisionals. Because we allow the swimmers to choose their events based on ladder. We seed divisionals directly in TM.
